MOVIE DESCRIPTIONS:

“Wonder” (Drama, Rated PG) Based on the New York Times bestseller, WONDER tells the incredibly inspiring and heartwarming story of August Pullman, a boy with facial differences who enters fifth grade, attending a mainstream elementary school for the first time.

“Despicable me 3” (animation/sci-fi, Rated PG) The team who brought you Despicable Me, Despicable Me 2 and Minions, returns to continue the adventures of Gru, Lucy, their adorable daughters - Margo, Edith and Agnes - and the Minions. Villain Balthazar Bratt is a former child star who's grown up to become obsessed with the character he played in the 80s, and proves to be Gru's most formidable nemesis to date.

TICKET SALES:

Tickets are \$10 per person and include unlimited popcorn and drinks. Discounts will be offered to families purchasing 4 or more tickets for their *IMMEDIATE* family members (only) at a reduced rate of \$9 per ticket.

Tickets may be purchased 2 ways:

or
- (2) during dismissal times during the week of November 27th thru December 1st.

Tickets **MUST** be pre-purchased. We are unable to accommodate “walk ins.”

ALL attendees **MUST** purchase a ticket for entry.

Infants will not be permitted inside the theatre; however, accommodations may be considered for a parent to remain in the lounge with their infant during the movie viewing. Please contact PTO directly for any special requests of this nature.

No Refunds will be accepted after Friday, December 1st.

Ticket holders MUST provide Ticket Stub upon arriving to the event for entrance. Please be sure to retain your ticket upon purchase.

OTHER:
